The Diaconate invites you to a special musical service on Sunday June 12<sup>th</sup> at 9:30. A Choral Reflection will be provided by the International Veterans Chorus.

The International Veterans Chorus was founded in Sept 2002 by Donna Allard with the idea of educating children in our schools about the important role our veterans have played so that we may live in a free democracy.

The chorus started with 10 members and has had as many as 45 members at one time. We currently have 22 members and have another roster of auxiliary members that we continue to invite to special events.

The IVC is based out of Leominster Veterans
Center. We are a community chorus with members
coming from various towns, including Clinton and
Templeton. We sing patriotic and seasonal songs at
civic events, schools, and churches.

Our members range in age from 41 to 96. Over the years our members have served in the British Army, the Hungarian and Japanese Forces.

All members are Military Veterans. We have a support team that is staffed by those with a heart for veterans. All members and leaders are volunteers. We have a board of directors, and are a 501c3 financed by donations.

Our performance seasons are Sept to Dec, and March to June.

### Strawberry Shortcake Booth

The last Town Benefit Day on Academy Hill was held in 2019. The 2020 and 2021 events were cancelled due to the pandemic.

As a form of Christian outreach within our local community, our Church was asked if we would like to participate in the Town Benefit Day events by supporting a Strawberry Shortcake Booth, similar to what we had at the old Yankee Street Fair events.

This year's event runs from 11:00 AM until 5:00 PM on Sunday, August 14<sup>th</sup>. In the past, the strawberries, biscuits, and whipped cream were provided by a generous Church member as well as a local restaurant with the bowls, spoons and napkins provided by the Town Benefit Committee. The Church participation is mostly providing labor for six hours maximum (typically broken into 2 hour shifts). The muscles used most are facial with smiles and laughter throughout!



# OCEAN WATER

After a busy summer day, relax in the shade with this cool drink.



### What you need:

- 3 Tablespoons water
- 3 Tablespoons sugar
- 1 teaspoon coconut extract
- 3 drops blue food coloring
- 24 oz. (2 cans) lemon-lime soda
- Clear cup or glass
- Ice
